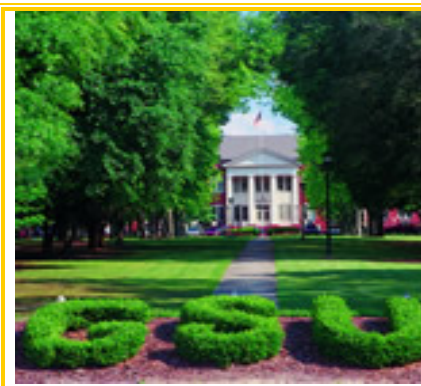

He has authored over 250 papers and 7 books on mathematics. He is the MAA Pólya Lecturer for 2007-2009.
